1791	William Hood is born	
1823	William becomes Coxswain of the first lifeboat in Seaton Carew	
1823	William's son Robert is born	
1826	William's son William is born	
1834	William's son Henry is born	
1836	William's son Charles is born	
1837	Queen Victorian starts her reign	
1851	Henry Hood starts work as a Mariners Apprentice	
1855	William Hood dies, he had saved more than 188 lives during his time working on the lifeboat.	
1855	Robert Hood takes over as Coxswain of the Seaton Lifeboat	
1857	Henry gets married to Mary Alison Brownbridge	
1861	11 <sup>th</sup> February a terrible storm causes lots of shipwrecks off the Hartlepool coast	
1861	Henry Hood lives at 5 Pilot Street, Stranton, West Hartlepool and his occupation is listed as a (boat) pilot. A pilot's job was to guide the ships into the harbour safely in a small row boat.	
1867	Robert retires and Henry takes over as Coxswain of the Seaton Carew lifeboat	
1871	Henry Hood lives in Ashburn Street, Seaton Carew with his wife Mary Alison	
1883	Norwegian ship 'Atlas' gets in trouble off the coast of Hartlepool. Henry Hood and two of his crew John and Matthew Franklin put on a very daring rescue of all five of the Atlas crew which earns them silver medals. Henry also received the Albert Medal of the second class from Queen Victoria.	
1898	Henry retires and is given a silver watch, £30 and a gold chain from his crew, friends and family for all his hard work on the lifeboats. During his time in charge, 89 lives were saved.	
1901	Queen Victoria dies and King Edward VII takes over	
1913	Henry Hood dies, he leaves his medals and silver watch to his niece in his will.	
2010	A family find medals and a silver watch in their attic, they found out they were relatives of Henry Hood and donated the objects to the Museum of Hartlepool so others could learn of the brave family of lifeboat men.
